















On-Line Self Paced Training Opportunity for Public Officers

The Ministry of Public Service in partnership with UNDP is implementing the Spotlight Initiative, an EU/UN-funded joint program to eliminate Violence Against Women and Girls (VAWG), Violence Against Children (VAC), and Harmful Practices (HPs) and Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights (SRHR).

One of the interventions supported by this program under the Ministry of Public Service is the online training in Gender-Based Violence Responsive Planning and Budgeting by Civil Service College Uganda, for Ministries, Departments and Agencies, and Local Governments (MDAs and LGs), tenable at the Civil Service College Uganda.

In this regard, the Ministry of Public Service launched an online self-paced training course in Planning and Budgeting for GBV Mainstreaming for Public Officers in MDAs and LGs. Undertaking this course will be of added advantage in enhancing Planning and Budgeting skills for GBV in Public entities as emphasized by Hon. Wilson Muruuli Mukasa, Minister for Public Service during the launch of the program.

The Self-paced course should be completed within 45 days after the commencement date of 13th June 2022. A Certificate of Course Completion shall be automatically generated/awarded on completion of this e-Course.
